Open Palmeraie Country Club 2019: Maiden win for the Scot Kevin Duncan

Scot Kevin Duncan confidently secured his first victory on the Pro Golf Tour in Morocco with strong putts and two fabulous rounds of 63 strikes on days 2 and 3 of the Open Palmeraie Country Club 2019. Finally the 30-year-old was four strokes ahead of his rivals in the 5th Pro Golf Tour 2019 tournament which took place at the "Palmeraie Country Club" and "The Tony Jacklin Casablanca" courses in Casablanca.

Casablanca/Morocco - He curled his drives down the middle of the fairway all week, his irons were just as precise and he even made the putts from a distance: with rounds of 69 and 63 strokes twice, Kevin Duncan was brilliant in Casablanca and celebrated his first tournament victory on the Pro Golf Tour with 19 under par. After 54 holes he was four strokes ahead of the Englishman Darren Walkley and the Moroccan Ahmed Marjan, who shared second place with 15 under par. For the biggest win of his career, he receives EUR 5,000 in prize money and climbs to 5th place in the Pro Golf Tour Order of Merit.

"After the last season, I actually wanted to stop playing tour golf. I'm all the more thrilled of course that it's worked out with the first victory now. It was worth carrying on. I'm over the moon," Duncan said after his win. "My putts worked brilliantly and the tee-offs were also very good. My whole game felt very solid," said the professional from Ellon, Scotland. At first the German Allen John had dominated the tournament for two days and took first place with rounds of 61 and 67 strokes. But on the final day at the "Palmeraie Country Club" course, John nosedived and ended up signing 75 strokes on his scorecard, falling back to 11th place. The best Germans were finally Hurly Long, David Heinzinger and Maximilian Oelfke with 14 under par sharing 4th place with the Frenchman Robin Sciot-Siegrist.

The Pro Golf Tour is now in Morocco for the 10th consecutive year and offers the players excellent golf courses there for a successful start to the season. Together with the Moroccan experts from the Association du Trophée Hassan II de Golf, who are also responsible for the European Tour and Ladies European Tour tournaments in Morocco, providing referees and supporting the organization, the Pro Golf Tour guarantees its members the ideal start of the season on demanding and well-maintained courses. The next time on the 3rd of March when the first round of the Open Madaef Golfs 2019 will take place on the "Casa Green Golf" course in Casablanca (www.pro-golf-tour.com).
